Wind Indicator and Crescendo Indicator on console. Three pistons for each manual.

Blower: Kinetic rated for 3.5" wind pressure, with 1 h.p. Century motor. This organ stands in the center of the gallery. It is completely original

and undamaged, but has been unplayable for years, presumably due to deterioration of chest leathers. Reservoir leathers brittle but still sound. The console is detached in front and the action is tubular-pneumatic with ventil chests, but with a mechanical swell pedal linkage. The pipework is in excellent condition. Metal pipes are of spotted metal with zinc basses, and tuned by slots. All Pedal pipes are full length.

Dimensions are 8'-5" deep by 18' wide. Impost is 5' high; rough estimate of height to tallest façade pipe is about 18', but somewhat less to top of swellbox. Arrangement is Swell behind Great, with Pedal pipes divided evenly on each side.
