

SAINT JAMES CATHOLIC CHURCH

2942 South Wabash Avenue, Chicago, Illinois

This parish was founded in 1855 and the first church was built in 1858. The present church was constructed between 1875 and 1880 in the Victorian Gothic style to designs by Patrick C. Keely. The building suffered a catastrophic fire in December of 1972, which destroyed most of the interior, with the exception of the organ. The church was reconstructed and reopened in 1976. The tower houses a twenty-bell chime cast by the McShane Bell Foundry of Baltimore, Maryland, in 1895.

The first organ in the present building was constructed in 1871 for the earlier church by the Pilcher Brothers of Chicago, opus 125. The present organ was built by Frank Roosevelt, successor to Hilborne L. Roosevelt, New York City, New York, in 1891 as opus

494. The instrument features two manuals, twenty-six ranks, with tracker-pneumatic key action, mechanical coupler and combination action. Manual compass is 58 notes; pedal compass is 30 notes, with a flat pedalboard. The Organ Historical Society has honored the instrument with its Historic Organ Citation. The organ awaits a thorough restoration project.
